creaked as the wind howled around its

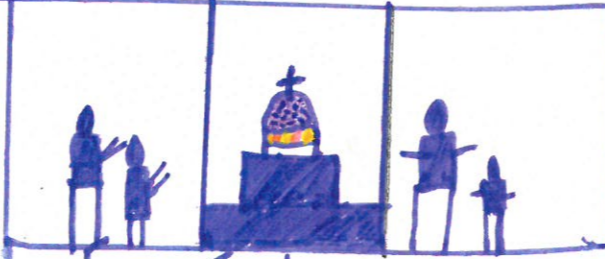
rotten walls. The sounding ~~walls~~ trees looked as

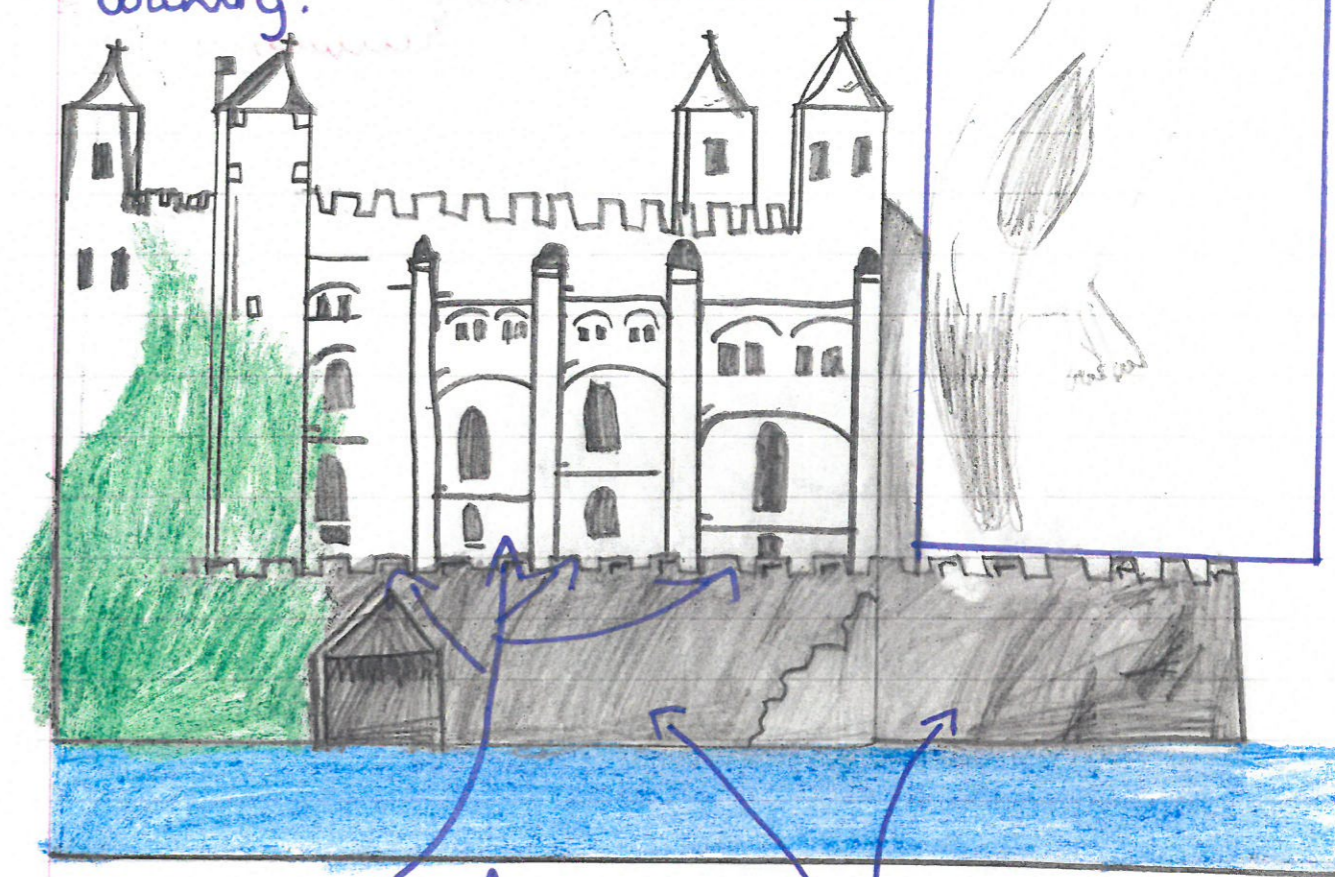
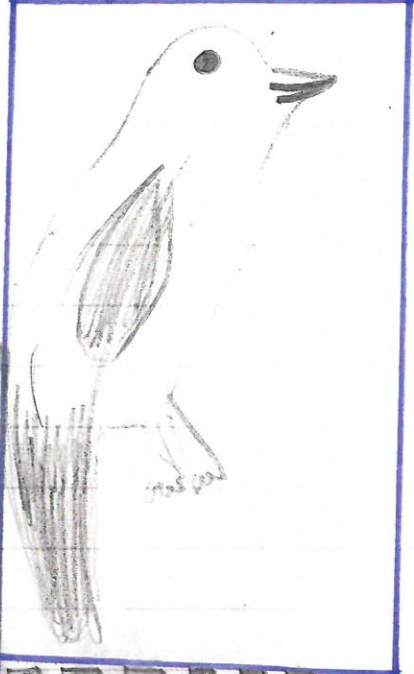




Prison cells
